\* Township will be responsible for 50% of engineering and inspection costs in addition to percentage shown for bridge construction cost.

\*\* No Township contribution required for Primary roads designated as All-Season, Thoroughfare, or are on Township Lines. Thoroughfares are defined as roads that are continuous and connect county lines or State Highways. They are identified as Mackinaw Trail (Meceola Rd to County Line Rd), 20 Mile Road (Lakola Rd to Clareola Rd) & 80th Avenue (US-10 to M-115).

Additional notes:

- > Township agreements under the policy will state "cost not to exceed".
- > Road Commission to invoice 50% of the estimated township cost at start of construction and, if requested, consider allowing installment payments over less than two (2) years to pay off the balance if full payment would reduce the township's general fund below a \$100,000 balance.
