## **FOR FIBER OPTIC CABLE INSTALLATION ON COUNTY ROAD RIGHT OF WAYS**

1. All fiber Optic cables will be outside of right-of-way if at all possible, including but not limited to the necessity of acquiring easement by fee from landowners.
2. The Osceola County Road Commission accepts no liability for damage to Fiber Optic cables, by itself or its contractors, nor from any unspecified individual or companies and corporations not engaged in work for the Osceola County Road Commission, that may or may not be authorized to work in Osceola County Road Commission's Right-of-ways.
3. The Osceola County Road Commission will contact "Miss Dig" for cable locating before working around a cable area.
4. Any digging, or cable verification beyond machine digging will be the responsibility of the company or corporation charged with overseeing maintenance, or locating cables.
5. No open cutting or plowing of cable is allowed through hard surface roads in Osceola County.
6. Directional boring is allowed no less than sixty inches (60 in.) below the bottom of the hard surface on roads.
7. Open cutting or plowing of cable is allowed when crossing non-hard surface roads; however, the Osceola County Road Commission encourages the use of directional boring on these roads also.
8. All cables will be placed 29 feet from the section line. Any variances shall first be approved by the Osceola County Road Commission.
9. All cables will be placed a minimum of 60 inches below bottom of ditches and/or centerline, whichever is deeper.
10. In some instances, the Osceola County Road Commission will require that extra cable be coiled and stored in suitable structures to allow for grade changes in future road work.
11. There shall be absolutely no use of tracked machines on hard surfaced roads in Osceola County.
12. All plow trenches or open cuts, either across roadway or off the roadway shall be stabilized with the proper material and sufficiently compacted to prevent settling and water absorption.

13. The Osceola County Road Commission will mark its culverts with 3 working days' notice.
14. All permit applications shall be accompanied by a set of drawings of the proposed project explicitly marking areas of proposed work within the Right-of-ways.
15. Other information is expressed on the back of Form CRA100 permit application.
